Various types of assembly work, craft production, and recycling take place within our facility.



Our personal fitness program incorporates the services of the Regional Fitness Center on the campus of the University of Minnesota, Morris.

We provide a comprehensive program which will enable our clients to become as independent as possible. Our services are designed to increase community integration, productivity and income, and interaction with non-disabled individuals.

Services are provided in a manner that is age appropriate and respectful of the dignity of the individual.

Our program emphasizes those skills necessary for independent living with greatest emphasis on vocational training and job skills. The majority of our clients are involved in supported community employment.



Current community-based job placements include various types of janitorial work, automobile detailing, nursing home assistants, restaurant work, lawn care and dishwashing.



The D.A.C. will provide job coaches for job skill training when necessary. We also assist employers with Department of Labor regulations. Employers looking for dependable workers should contact the D.A.C. office.
